

ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2023

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY
AMENDING ORDINANCE 3, 1997, SECTION 38.10 OF THE CATLETTSBURG
CITY CODE, TO UPDATE SMALL PURCHASE LIMITATION TO \$30,000.00
CONSISTENT WITH KRS 45A.385 AND REPEALING ANY SECTIONS OF
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

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WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly has increased the limitation for small purchases under the Kentucky Model Procurement Code, and

WHEREAS, the Council in adopting its Procurement Code by Ordinance 3, 1997 adopted the provisions of KRS 45A.345 to KRS 45A.460 including the then existing small purchase limitation contained in KRS 45A.385

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG,
KENTUCKY:**

SECTION 1. The Catlettsburg City Code Section 38.10 (Ordinance No. 3, 1997) is amended to read as follows: The City may use small purchase procedures for any contract for which a determination is made that the aggregate amount does not exceed ~~\$7500~~ \$30,000, as the small purchase procedures are in writing and available to the public.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and held for naught.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as required by law.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF

RELATING TO TEVA, CVS, ALLERGAN,
WALMART & WALGREEN AND THE KYOAAAC
CERTIFICATION RELATING TO THE
LITIGATION HANDLED BY GRABHORN LAW
OFFICE, PLLC PURSUANT TO THE LEGAL
SERVICES AGREEMENT AUTHORIZED BY
ORDINANCE NO. 19, 2021 ON BEHALF OF THE
CITY REGARDING THE EXISTING OPIOID
LITIGATION.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 19, 2021 GRABHORN LAW OFFICE (“GRABHORN”) has filed litigation representing various municipalities within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including the City of Catlettsburg, against various entities responsible for the manufacture, distribution, marketing and sale of opioid medications in an irresponsible manner resulting in vast numbers of citizens of the Commonwealth becoming addicted to opioids and that of local governments where they reside that litigation has been instituted to recover damages from those responsible for the damages resulting from such epidemic, and


WHEREAS, there have been settlements reached with Teva, Allergan, CVS, WalMart and Walgreen and it is in the City’s best interest to join in such litigation per the direction of GRABHORN Law Office and execute a settlement participation form regarding these entities.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY:
