

ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2023

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE UPDATED "PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY, FEBRUARY 2023" AND REPEALING EXISTING PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS FOUND IN CHAPTER 38 OF THE CATLETTSBURG CITY CODE.**

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**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky adopted as the law of the Commonwealth of Kentucky the Kentucky Model Procurement Code which was codified as Chapter 45A of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and

**WHEREAS**, the said Kentucky Model Procurement Code provides that the City of Catlettsburg may adopt any of the other provisions of the Procurement Code and may make modifications of such provisions, provided, however, that such modifications shall not be inconsistent with the Kentucky Procurement Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CATLETTSBURG, KENTUCKY:**

**SECTION 1.** That the "Procurement Regulations for the City of Catlettsburg, Kentucky, February 2023" which are attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, are hereby adopted as if set out in full.


**SECTION 2.** Chapter 38 of the Catlettsburg City Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION 3.** It shall be considered that it is the intent of the City of Catlettsburg in enacting this ordinance that if any part of it should be held unconstitutional, the remaining parts shall remain in force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances of the City of Catlettsburg and any parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict only, are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, readoption and publication, as required by law.

**SECTION 6.** It is hereby authorized that publication of this ordinance be in summary form.
